future directions It is widely known that it is hard to pull a major paper together on this theme but so many scientists know of at least one matter that they would like to draw to public attention So short contributions are included Listen to the speakers present some overarching themes or compelling case studies contribute to the debate on the day then examine your stance on a variety of these subjects to see whether the day changes your view of this often cryptic aspect of zoology As editors we wish to acknowledge the skills of the referees all papers were refereed by two peers and the patience of the authors for what has been a long gap between the date of the forum and this publication By the end of 2008 the Royal Zoological Society of NSW along with everyone else was caught by the GFC Global Financial Crisis and we simply had to extend the length of the queue for publication We also reassessed our mode of publication The Council of the Society voted to publish this production as an ebook as well as a short print run for formal library deposit and other essential matters.
