Elisabeth Vigée Lebrun 1755-1842 was an enormously successful painter a favorite portraitist of Marie Antoinette and one of the few women accepted into the Royal Academy of Painting and Sculpture In her role as an artist she was simultaneously flattered as a charming woman and vilified as monstrously unfeminine In *The Exceptional Woman* Mary D.
