Searching for the lost space of Ottoman visions of the sea The Red Sea makes a deeper argument about the discipline of history and the historian's craft.

Literary authors have frequently called on elements of cartography to ground fictional space to visualize sites and to help readers get their bearings in the imaginative world of the text. Today the convergence of digital mapping and globalization has spurred a cartographic turn in literature. This book gathers leading scholars to consider the relationship of literature and cartography. Generously illustrated with full color maps and visualizations it offers the first systematic overview of an emerging approach to the study of literature. The literary map is not merely an illustrative guide but represents a set of relations and tensions that raise questions about representation, fiction and space. Is literature even mappable?
