Creating Kosovo Elton Skendaj, 2014-12-18 In shaping the institutions of a new country what interventions from international actors lead to success and failure Elton Skendaj s investigation into Kosovo based on national survey data interviews and focus groups conducted over ten months of fieldwork leads to some surprising answers Creating Kosovo highlights efforts to build the police force the central government courts and a customs service Skendaj finds that central administration and the courts which had been developed under local authority succumbed to cronyism and corruption challenging the premise that local ownership leads to more effective state bureaucracies.
