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1. ANALYSIS OF QUESTION BY QUESTION PERFORMANCE

The aim for setting Paper 3 is to assess learning outcome 3: Process writing(an intergrated approach: LO 1,2,3 and 4)

The learner should be able to demonstrate the use of planning skills for writing for a specific purpose. To develop coherent ideas and organise these by using techniques such as mind maps, digrams ,list, key words and flow charts.

The learners should demonstrate the use of writing strategies for first drafts, so that they should use main and supporting ideas from planning process. To use a variety of sentence types,to apply paragraph conventions to ensure coherence and use conjunctions, pronouns and adverbs to ensure cohesion.

The learners should reflect on, analayse evaluate and edit their own work.

QUESTION 1

- 1.1. Learners did not respond well in this question. They only focussed on the Xhosa culture and failed to discuss other racial cultures as illustrated in the question paper.
- 1.2. This question was well answered by the majority of learners. This is reflected in the marks they have obtained. This overwhelming response can be attributed to the fact that the topic was about the use of cellular phones which they are really fond of.
- 1.3. Few students attempted to answer this question due to either ignorance or lack of information regarding the importance of newspaper or magazine reading, thus failing to sharpen their reading skills.
- 1.4. Those learners who have chosen this topic have failed to specify their requests or suggestions to the State President whom they had to 'imaginary' meet, as a result they put forward the state of affairs in South Africa (mainly bad) which defeated the purpose of the question.

Shaping Natural History and Settler Society Tanja Hammel, 2019-08-23 This book explores the life and work of Mary Elizabeth Barber a British born settler scientist who lived in the Cape during the nineteenth century It provides a lens into a range of subjects within the history of knowledge and science gender and social history postcolonial critical heritage and archival studies The book examines the international importance of the life and works of a marginalized scientist the instrumentalisation of science to settlers political concerns and reveals the pivotal but largely silenced contribution of indigenous African experts Including a variety of material visual and textual sources this study explores how these artefacts are archived and displayed in museums and critically analyses their content and silences The book traces Barber s legacy across three continents in collections and archives offering insights into the politics of memory and history making At the same time it forges a nuanced argument incorporating study of the North and South the history of science and social history and the past and the present

Falling Monuments, Reluctant Ruins Hilton Judin, 2021-06-01 This edited collection looks at ruins and vacant buildings as part of South Africa s oppressive history of colonialism and apartheid and ways in which the past persists into the present Falling Monuments Reluctant Ruins The Persistence of the Past in the Architecture of Apartheid interrogates how in the era of decolonization post apartheid South Africa reckons with its past in order to shape its future Architects historians artists social anthropologists and urban planners seek answers in this book to complex and unsettling questions around heritage ruins and remembrance What do we do with hollow memorials and political architectural remnants Which should remain which forgotten and which dismantled Are these vacant buildings cemeteries statues and derelict grounds able to serve as
