Classes of Molecules Found in Cells

- **Lipids:** Long chains of carbon and hydrogen that generally don't like water

EX: Oils and fats

- **Proteins:** Made up of amino acids; carry out most of the functions of the cell
- **Carbohydrates:** Also known as sugars; used for energy and storage, as well as for building structures around cells
- **DNA/Ribonucleic acids:** Double-stranded hereditary molecules of all cells that contain the **code** for the cell and is used to directly make RNA molecules in a process called **transcription**
- **RNA (ribonucleic acids):** Molecules are similar to DNA but are single stranded and make proteins in a process called **translation**

These five substances are used to make up most of what goes into all living organisms.

We eat things such as lipids, proteins, and carbohydrates to get the raw materials to build our cells.

Cells

Cells are the basic unit of life.

Organisms are specialized structures in cells to carry out particular functions.

Prokaryotic Cells

- Lack nuclei and are generally simpler than eukaryotic cells
- Bacteria are typical prokaryotic cells.
- Have a single circular DNA molecule
- Have a cell membrane made up of two layers of lipids with hydrophilic (water-loving) heads and hydrophobic (water-fearing) tails
- Reproduce by **binary fission** where one cell separates into two cells. They do not need any other organism to reproduce.
- Do not have any internal membranes to create separate spaces in the cell
- Have a cell wall made up of proteins and carbohydrates that protect the cell

Eukaryotic Cells

- Have nuclei and are often larger and more complex than prokaryotic cells
- Usually have multiple chromosomes that are more organized than DNA in prokaryotes
- Have membrane-bound organelles that create specialized environments, increasing efficiency
- Can form multicellular organisms where cells take on specialized functions
- May or may not have cell walls. Animal cells lack cell walls, but plants and some cells have them.
- May undergo sexual reproduction, which requires two different sexes to produce specialized reproductive cells

Prokaryotic & Eukaryotic Cell Structures

- **Cell walls:** Protective structures surrounding some organisms, made up of carbohydrates and proteins
 - **Cilia:** Short, thin projections that help move a cell or create currents around a cell
 - **Flagella:** Long, thin projections that spin and are used to move a cell
- **Basal bodies:** Protein structures that serve as a base for cilia and flagella to move
- **Cell membranes:** Lipid bilayers that form a barrier between the inside and outside of a cell
- **Ribosomes (RNA):** Made up of proteins and RNA; used to make proteins; not membrane-bound

Eukaryotic Cell Structures



- **Nucleolus (RNA):** A specialized region of the nucleus used to make ribosomes
- **Nucleoplasm:** Membrane-bound structure holding the DNA of a cell
- **Vesicles (RNA):** Membrane-bound organelles that can trap material inside of the membrane and either bring it into the cell (endocytosis) or release it from the cell (exocytosis)
- **Rough endoplasmic reticulum (RNA):** Used to synthesize membrane proteins and secreted proteins
- **Golgi complex (RNA):** Membrane-bound organelle used to sort proteins into their correct locations and to add complex carbohydrates to cells
- **Cytoskeleton (RNA):** Internal protein structure that supports the cell and gives molecules tracks on which they can move within a cell
- **Smooth endoplasmic reticulum (ER) (RNA):** Used to synthesize lipids
- **Mitochondria (RNA):** Membrane-bound organelles used to make ATP, the main energy molecule of a cell, using membrane folds called cristae
- **Nucleus (RNA):** Membrane-bound storage organelle that has very large in plant cells
- **Centrioles (RNA):** Serve as a base structure to pull chromosomes apart during cell division
- **Chloroplasts:** Membrane-bound structures that convert light energy into chemical energy through photosynthesis using internal membrane folds called **thylakoids**
- **Peroxisomes:** Membrane-bound organelles that isolate reactions that require hydrogen peroxide, which if not restricted, could kill the cell
- **Lysosomes:** Membrane-bound organelles that isolate digestive reactions, which if not restricted, could damage or kill the cell

Viruses

- Use DNA or RNA as their genetic material
- Always have proteins on their surface that determine what type of cell they can infect
- Sometimes have a membrane around them to envelope the rest of the virus
- Always take over the machinery of the infected cell to make more virus particles
- May kill a cell quickly or infect a cell for a long time and make more viruses slowly
- Can often cause disease in humans
- Can infect all types of cells, from bacteria, to plants, to humans, depending on the virus

Cell Metabolism & Energy

- All life uses energy sources of a cell
 - Animals break down sugars, particularly glucose, to make ATP
- **Aerobic metabolism:** Breakdown of carbohydrates, fat, or proteins in the presence of oxygen, more efficient
 - Formula: $C_6H_{12}O_6 + 6O_2 \rightarrow 6H_2O + 6CO_2$
- **Fermentation (anaerobic metabolism):** Breakdown of sugar in the absence of oxygen

- Fermentation used in making beer and bread results in the production of alcohol

Health Issues

 - Male: Sperm
 - Female: Egg
- Each human gamete contains 23 chromosomes made up of DNA and proteins
- The chromosomes contain one copy of every gene that provides a blueprint to make a person
- You have two copies of every gene — one from each parent (diploid)

Saitluanga, 2017-04-18 The book is a study of intra urban inequality in quality of life QOL in Aizawl city The main objectives of the study include analysis of processes and patterns of social differentiation along the three dimensional space of Aizawl city as well as analysis of spatial inequality in QOL at the lowest administrative structure of the city An investigation into spatial pattern of residential differentiation was done at both horizontal and vertical spaces Spatial variation in well being of residents of Aizawl city and the quality of their immediate environment was also studied by taking both objective and subjective indicators The study employed a number of descriptive inferential and multivariate statistical techniques including correlation factor analysis principal component analysis cluster analysis and spatial autocorrelation methods like Moran's I and Local Indicators of Spatial Association LISA Mapping techniques and graphical methods like Choropleth map histogram and line graph were also used With the help of factor analysis the social space of Aizawl city was found to be differentiated along socio economic status family status household size status workers status and ethnic status The most important factor determining residential differentiation was socio economic status Choropleth map of factor scores reveals that the inner city localities were dominated by high socio economic class while poorer people dominated the peripheries Non local ethnic minorities were few but concentrated in some adjoining peripheral localities as well as in inner city localities which have been inhabited by their ancestors since the colonial period Vertical pattern of residential differentiation was also analyzed by taking income variable as a proxy of socio economic status Multi storey buildings in Aizawl city were co inhabited by both richer people and poorer people The richer people were found at the top floors while the poorer people occupied the basement floors Normally the owners of the buildings were found at the top floors while the basement floors were dominated by the renters Spatial variation in QOL was measured with the help of principal component analysis as a weighting technique by taking variables pertaining to both objective and subjective QOL dimensions The values of composite QOL index showed that the central localities have scored better than their peripheral counterparts Correlation analysis of the relationship between objective indicators and subjective indicators provided a low positive value indicating the absence of relationship between the two dimensions of quality of life Spatial autocorrelation analysis was also performed to see the pattern of clustering of spatially weighted QOL variables across Local Councils With the help of Global Moran's I spatial clusters and spatial outliers were observed for objective dimension of QOL within the study area The value of Moran's I was found to be insignificant for subjective QOL dimension indicating the absence of significant pattern of clustering The study also identified 7 social areas of Aizawl city on the basis of factor scores and composite scores of QOL variables calculated for all Local Councils The identification of clusters was taken out with the help of hierarchical clustering method of cluster analysis These

clusters were labeled appropriate names and their characteristics were described in detail The thesis concluded with recommendation of designating these social areas as social development planning zones for obtaining inclusive development
