They moved into the region from Asia thousands of years ago.
- List the reasons people have immigrated to North America.
Seek political + religious freedom + to find better economic opportunities. Others fled wars or natural disasters.
- What made the United States and Canada attractive destinations to immigrants?
Rich natural resources + the region's rapid industrial + economic development (industry and technology)
- Where do most people in the United States and Canada live? ^{People live} Canada live along the US border
They live in metropolitan areas (NE, Great Lakes, Pacific Coast) + Burash
- How did the development of large commercial farms affect the United States?
It caused cities to grow as the use of machines in agriculture gave rise to large commercial farms. Workers moved to the city.
- Describe the differences between a metropolitan area and a megalopolis. Metropolitan ^{500,000 people or more}
A chain of closely-linked metropolitan areas forms a megalopolis
- What natural features are important to inland cities?
Rivers, lakes, and inland waterways
- Explain the importance of the St. Lawrence River.
Ships reach the cities of Quebec, Montreal, Toronto, + Ottawa through the St. Lawrence ^{river}
- What do the cities of Atlanta, Denver, and San Antonio in the United States, and Regina and Calgary in Canada have in common?
They grew from agricultural + trading centers
- Why is immigration important to the region now?
It accounts for most of the region's population growth / immigration
