1. Lay out a basic outline of what the essay is supposed to do. Ask questions during class to find out if there are any off limits sources. 3. For all those who are beginning to write essays, there are certain rules or tips that can help them to create a perfect essay. Always include the personal experiences, as the readers are not interested in what happened with your family and friends. Do not make personal attacks, when you are writing on any issue that
