all communities and those which vary Residential segregation is shown to be a prominent and enduring feature of American urban society By bringing empirical data to bear on an important and timely social problem this book will aid in the search for reasonable solutions All types of cities southern and northern large and small are beset with the difficulties that residential segregation imposes on harmonious race relations and on the solution of pressing city prob
