fastest way to assess if hair is natural or synthetic - answer -pull the strand out of the wig or hairpiece and burn w/a match. human hair burns slowly and has a distinctive odor, synthetic fiber balls up and melts, extinguishing itself (typical of Kanekalon), or will continue to burn and burn out very quickly (typical of polyester)
-synthetic fibers have no odor when burned

human hair - answer -more realistic appearance
-greater durability
-same styling and maintenance as natural human hair (can be permed, custom colored, be blown dry and used with a curling iron or hot rollers)

human hair - answer -reacts to climate as natural human hair (may frizz or lose curl in humidity)
-needs resetting after a shampoo (challenging for client's at-home maintenance)
-color will oxidize (fade from light exposure)
-breaks and splits from harsh brushing, backcombing or excessive use of heat

synthetic hair - answer -modacrylic is very durable and strong
-modacrylics such as Kanekalon simulate natural hair with a natural and lustrous finish and feel
-extremely realistic looking, even to professional stylists
-less expensive than human hair
-convenient to maintain due to the style and texture being set into the hair (not altered by shampooing in cold water or extreme humidity)
-already cut according to modern styles with cut, color and texture inherent
