feminism also in Ethiopia do not address hard lived gender norms and the power and domination dynamics entailed when parity between boys and girls in school continues to be the dominant measure for equity Despite women s courageous contribution at a literal frontier during the Tigrayan liberation struggle 1975 91 where they fought on equal terms with men and despite the tendency that girls outnumber boys at secondary level in the present context sanctioned femaleness constitutes a frontier for girls educational success and transition to higher education In fact when teaching learning continues to be based on memorization rather than critical thinking the very transformative potential of education is undermined also in a gendered sense
