Loan

- U.S. citizen or eligible noncitizen
- Enrolled in eligible degree or certification program
- Demonstrate financial need (Direct Subsidized)



Eligibility

- Usually lower
- Fixed



Interest

- Eight possible repayment plans
- Option to change plans
- May qualify for longer, income-driven repayment plans
- May qualify for loan forgiveness



Repayment

- Deferred interest payments while in school and for six months after graduation



Grace Period

Private Student Loans

- Set by individual lender, but may be based on credit history and score, income, career path, and more

- Usually higher
- Fixed or variable

- Terms set by individual lenders may vary
- May be penalized for changing repayment terms

- Usually no grace period
- Usually no option for deferment

Student Loans and Social Mobility Mehran Ebrahimian,2020 Students of poor families invest much less than rich families in college education To assess the role of financing constraints and subsidy schemes in explaining this gap I structurally estimate an IO finance model of college choice in the presence of financing frictions The estimation uses novel nationally representative data on US high school and college students I propose

a novel identification strategy that relies on bunching at federal Stafford loan limits and differences between in and out of state tuition I find that the college investment gap is mainly due to fundamental factors heterogeneity in preparedness for college and the value added of college rather than financing constraints faced by lower income students Making public colleges tuition free would substantially reduce student debt but it would disproportionately benefit wealthier students and it would entail more than 15B deadweight loss per year by distorting college choices Expanding Pell grants in contrast would benefit lower income students at a much lower cost
