# 1.Peoples and States in South-Central, Southwestern, and Western Ethiopia

### A. South-Central:

- Includes Hadiya, Halaba, Kambata, and Gurage which were autonomous and semi-autonomous political entities during this period.
- Economy: agriculture and trade. In terms of trade, the Gurage land was an important market center.

## Gurage:

- Soddo and Aymallel were its major trade centers during that time.
- Title of their leaders was called Abegaz or Azmatch and the leaders combined both political and military authority.

### Qabenna

- It emerged as a strong political entity in the second half of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and became a center of Muslim revivalist movement to the northeast of the Gibe River.
- It established connection with the people who came from Wollo and also perhaps with the Mahdist Sudan.
