to all foreign born workers Zeidel concludes that ironically stigmatizing immigrants as subversives contributed to the passage of the Quota Acts which effectively stemmed the flow of wanted foreign workers Post war employers argued for preserving America s traditional open door but the negativity that they had assigned to foreign workers contributed to its closing
