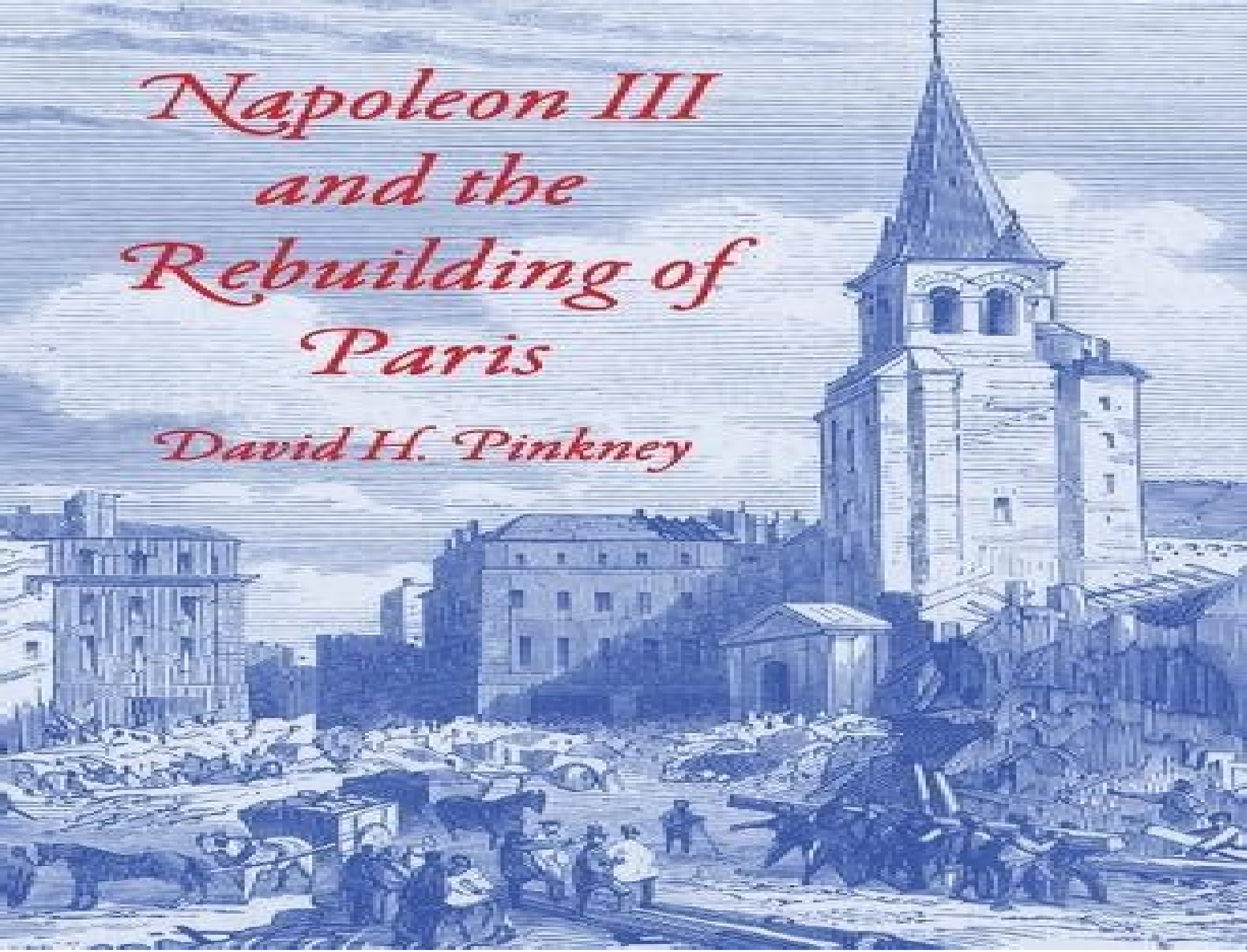

in the current day This book shows that while sex workers have been recruited to mark the borders of civic and moral life prostitution can also make space for more inclusive forms of community both in the novel and in the world beyond its bounds
