Civic Activism in South Korea Seungsook Moon, 2024-07-16 In recent decades neoliberalism has transformed South Korean society going far beyond simply restructuring the economy In response a number of civic organizations that emerged from the democratization movement with a conscious emphasis on social change have sought to address socioeconomic and political problems caused or aggravated by the neoliberal transformation Examining how citizens organizations in South Korea negotiate with the market and neoliberal governance Seungsook Moon offers new ways to understand the intricate relationship between democracy and neoliberalism as modes of ruling She provides in depth qualitative studies of three different types of organizations a large national advocacy organization run by professional staff activists two medium size local branches of a national feminist organization run by mostly volunteer

activists and a small local organization run by volunteer activists with a focus on foreign migrants Bringing together these rich empirical cases with deft theoretical analysis Moon argues that neoliberalism and democracy are entwined in complex ways Although neoliberalism undermines democratic practices of social equality by shrinking or destroying public resources institutions and space it also can facilitate participatory practices that arise to fill needs left by privatization and deregulation as long as those practices do not seriously challenge the workings of capitalism Showing how neoliberalism simultaneously enables and constrains civic activism this book illuminates the contradictions of social engagement today with global implications

Wandering Mind Jennifer Horne, 2024-01-11 Sara Mayfield was born into Alabama's governing elite in 1905 and grew up in a social circle that included Zelda Sayre Fitzgerald, Sara Haardt Mencken and Tallulah and Eugenia Bankhead. A precocious child, Mayfield befriended H. L. Mencken in college, then visited with the Fitzgeralds and hobnobbed with the literati while traveling in Europe after a failed marriage in the 1920s. Returning to Alabama during the Depression, she briefly ran the family plantation before departing for New York City where she became involved in the theatre. Inventing a plastic compound derived from cotton while working on theatrical sets, she applied for a patent and set her sights on a livelihood as an inventor and businesswoman. With the advent of World War II, Mayfield returned to her family home in Tuscaloosa where she expanded her experiments, freelanced as a journalist, and doggedly pursued a bizarre series of military and intelligence schemes, prompting temporary hospitalization. In 1945, she mingled with a host of cultural figures while reporting on the creation of the United Nations from Mexico and California, but she struggled to find her place in Tuscaloosa society after the war, becoming increasingly paranoid about conspiracies arrayed against her. Finally, her mother and brother committed her to Bryce Hospital for the Insane where she remained for the next seventeen years. Throughout her life, Mayfield kept journals, wrote fiction, and produced thousands of letters while nursing the overriding ambition that drove her since childhood: to write and publish books. During her confinement, Mayfield assiduously recorded her experiences and her determined efforts, sometimes delusional, always savvy, to overturn her diagnosis and return to the world as a sane, independent adult. At 59, she did just that, securing her release, having been returned to sanity, then publishing literary biographies of Mencken and the Fitzgeralds, plus a novel, finally achieving her lifelong quest to become an author of books and her own life. In *Odyssey of a Wandering Mind*, noted writer Jennifer Horne draws on years of research and an intimate understanding of the vast archive Mayfield left behind to sensitively render her struggle to move through the world as the person she was and her ultimate success in surviving to define the terms of her story.

Yet, as both a studio portraitist and a photojournalist, she broke with convention. Equally unconventional,

in her personal life Ker Seymer was prefigurative in the way she lived her life as a bisexual woman and in her contempt for racism misogyny and homophobia Fiercely independent for much of her life she rejected the idea of family preferring her wide set of creative friends with the artist Edward Burra ballet dancer William Billy Chappell and choreographer Frederick Ashton at its core Today Ker Seymer's photographs are known for whom they represent rather than the face behind the camera an irony underpinned by the misattribution of some of her most daring images to Cecil Beaton Yet her intelligence sparkle wit and genius enabled her to link arms with the surrealists the Bloomsbury Group the Bright Young Things and most gloriously the worlds of theatre cabaret and jazz With unprecedented access to private archives and hitherto unseen material Sarah Knights brings Barbara Ker Seymer and her brilliant bohemian friends vividly to life
