men women and children black and white Diaries and letters vividly portray the actions at Talana Elandsplaagte Colenso Acton Homes and Spion Kop as well as the siege of Ladysmith in which 15 000 military personnel and 2 500 residents and refugees were incarcerated for four months slowly but surely dying from starvation and sickness until their relief Before during and after the Boer War many myths were created and facts hidden to suit political ends The result was that lessons which should have been learned were never adequately understood or applied With the West still engaged in foreign wars these old mistakes should be remembered and not repeated Friends and Enemies is the result of years of intensive research undertaken in archives in both South Africa and Britain It offers an important and scholarly resource to students of nineteenth and twentieth century conflict
