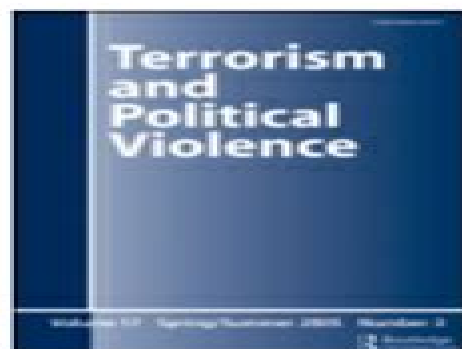

Friction Clark McCauley, Sophia Moskalenko, 2016-11-01 Terrorism is an extreme form of radicalization In this groundbreaking and important book Clark McCauley and Sophia Moskalenko identify and outline twelve mechanisms of political radicalization that can move individuals groups and the masses to increased sympathy and support for political violence Co authored by two psychologists both acknowledged in their field as experts in radicalization and consultants to the Department of Homeland Security and other government agencies *Friction* draws on wide ranging case histories to show striking parallels between 1800s anti czarist terrorism 1970s anti war terrorism and 21st century jihadist terrorism Altogether the twelve mechanisms of political radicalization demonstrate how unexceptional people are moved to exceptional violence in the conflict between states and non state challengers In this revised and expanded edition McCauley and Moskalenko use the twelve mechanisms to analyze recent cases of lone wolf terrorists and illustrate how individuals can become radicalized to jihadist violence with group influence or organizational support Additionally in the context of the Islamic State s worldwide efforts to radicalize moderate Muslims for jihad they advance a model that differentiates radicalization in opinion from radicalization in action and suggest different strategies for countering these diverse forms of radicalization As a result the authors conclude that the same mechanisms are at work in radicalizing both terrorists and states targeted by terrorists implying that these conclusions are as relevant for policy makers and security officers as they are for citizens facing the threat of terror today

The Violence Pendulum Ioana Emy Matesan, 2020-08-18 Would the Islamic State ever renounce violence In the current political climate the question seems preposterous Yet at the height of a terrorist campaign against tourists in Egypt during the 1990s nobody expected that the group behind the attacks would issue and adhere to a nonviolence initiative What drives groups to shift between nonviolence and violence When do opposition groups move away from armed action and why do some organizations renounce violence permanently whereas others refrain temporarily In *The Violence Pendulum* Ioana Emy Matesan offers a theory of tactical change that explains both escalation and de escalation in order to answer these questions Matesan s analysis traces the historical evolution of four Islamist groups the Muslim Brotherhood and al Gama a al Islamiyya in Egypt and Darul Islam and Jemaah Islamiyah in Indonesia Drawing from archival materials interviews and reports she focuses on turning points in each organization Ultimately she finds that Islamist groups alter their tactics in response to the perceived need for activism shifts in the cost of violent versus nonviolent resistance and internal or external pressures on the organization Groups turn to violence when grievances escalate violent resistance is feasible and publicly tolerated and there are internal or external pressures to act In turn groups renounce armed action when violence costs them too much disillusionment eclipses the perceived need for continued activism and leaders are willing to rethink the tactics and strategies of the group By uncovering the reasons for escalation and de escalation across a range of political environments *The Violence Pendulum* reshapes our

understanding of how decisions are made and how nonviolence can be achieved in armed groups
