In a streak test, we rub a SIS mineral on an unglazed, white tile and see what color streak 99 it leaves behind. Luster is the reflection of light from a 110 mineral. Minerals with a lot of luster look shiny. Sometimes 120 minerals are the same color, which is why we often cannot 131 use color to identify minerals. 136
