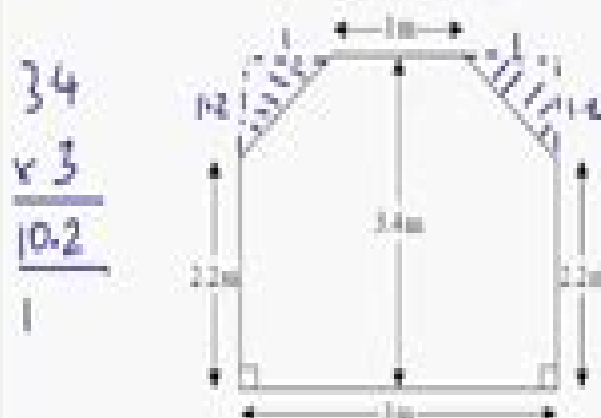


*18 The diagram shows the floor plan of Mary's conservatory.
