intelligence But as Massing's detailed analysis demonstrates pre war journalism was also deeply flawed as too many reporters failed to independently evaluate administration claims about Saddam's weapons programs or the inspection process The press s postwar feistiness stands in sharp contrast to its submissiveness and meekness before the war when it might have made a difference America's Destruction of Iraq Michael M.
