What is the difference between weather and climate?

- Weather refers to the temperature, cloud cover, wind and rain fall an area will experience.
- This may change from day to day! It might be sunny and hot on Monday, then
 a little cooler with a slight breeze on Tuesday.

Climate

Rain, snow, sunshine, wind and temperature.

The climate is the average weather conditions in a region, measured over a long period of time. By looking at the past measurements, meteorologists can calculate the average rainfall and temperature for certain areas.

Weather

Rain, sunshine, wind, temperature at a particular time.

The weather is determined by the atmospheric conditions in an area measured over a shorter period of time.

It can change quickly and is not constant throughout the day, week or month.

Hot, Mild and Cold Climates

A hot climate has a high average temperature.

This means that it is usually hot, but can be cooler at some times of the year.

A cold climate has a low average temperature.

A mild climate has an average temperature that is not to hot or too cold

The hottest places on Earth are found close to the equator. The warmest climate zones are deserts. Temperatures can reach 50°C.



The coldest areas are found at the North and South Poles. These are called tundra regions; the temperatures are very cold and few plants and animals are able to survive here
