student is assigned a research project. They create a detailed plan that includes selecting a topic, gathering resources, outlining key points, and establishing a timeline for completing different stages of the project.

Cognitive Flexibility:
During a group activity, a student is asked to switch from working on a math problem to contributing ideas for a collaborative writing project. The student demonstrates cognitive flexibility by smoothly transitioning between these different tasks.
