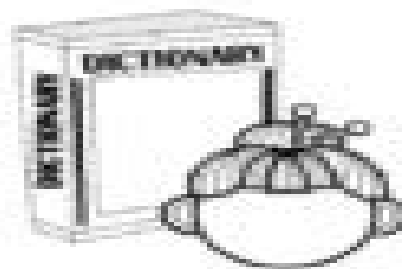

- Do you know anyone who has a reputation of being mean but is actually very nice?

- Would you try to do the ultimate teacher stopper? Why or why not?
