When blood glucose is too high:

Change is detected by β cells as glucose moves into them by facilitated diffusion.

(The liver also starts converting glucose \rightarrow glycogen. This reduces the concentration of glucose in the blood.)



Controlling

Insulin is secreted by β cells into the capillary. Insulin moves through the cell membrane and is released into the capillaries.

Insulin binds to target cells and binds to receptors on the cell membrane. Stimulates cells to increase the number of glucose transporter proteins in membranes. Glucose uptake is increased.

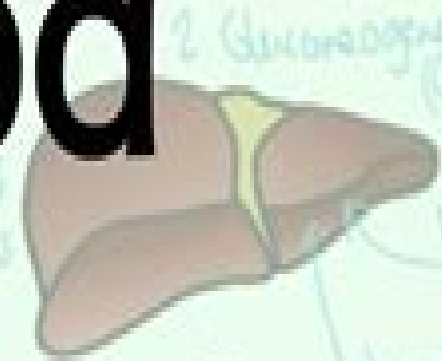
