- Proper noun – name
- Common noun – thing
 - Abstract noun – emotion/state of being
- Noun phrase – centred around a noun, e.g. a small island

Verbs

- Dynamic verbs – the situation described by the verb process changes over time, e.g. 'He ate the cake'
 - Stative verbs – state of being, feelings etc 'I think'
- Transitive verbs – followed by direct object e.g. 'I carried the baby'
- Intransitive verbs – do not need direct object, e.g. 'It happened'
- Lexical verbs – express the meaning of the verb phrase 'the boy ran to school'
- Auxiliary verbs – be, do, have

Modals

Convey a range of attitudes and moods

- Ability – I can
- Intention – You will
- Necessity/Obligation – You must
- Prediction – He will, I shall
- Permission – Can I, May I
- Possibility – I can, I may

- Subject (S) – Usually indicates the element responsible for carrying out the verb process
- Verb (V) – The verb phrase
- Object (O) – That affected by the action of the verb
- Complement (C) – When, Where, Destination, Manner
- Adverbial (A) – The circumstance of action or event (when, where, how)

Pre and Post Modification

Adjectives express some features or quality of a noun or pronoun

- Attributive – Premodifies the noun, e.g. 'a sad girl'
- Predicative – Occurs alone as a complement
- Comparative – Using -er and -est
- Superlative – Using more and most
- Descriptive – Focus on size, colour, material, height etc
- Evaluative – Add biased opinion, e.g. Scrawny rather than thin
- Emotive – Add an emotional opinion, e.g. Terrible, horrible

Grammar

Active and Passive

- Active – Includes an actor or agent; verb phrase includes a present or past tense verb 'Ms Watson closed the door' (SVO)
- Passive – Omits an actor or agent or includes the agent as part of the prepositional phrase after the verb 'The door was closed by Ms Watson' (OVS)

Sentence Moods

- Declarative – used for making statements – context bound
- Interrogative – Yes/No questions, Wh-interrogatives – more info
- Imperative – commands, direct address (elliptically), politeness markers to mitigate rudeness
- Exclamative – Use exclamation marks

Pronouns

- Personal – I, You, She, They, It
- Possessive – My, His, Our, Their
- Reflexive – Myself, Himself, Themselves
- Demonstrative – This, These, That, Those
- Relative – Who, Whom, Which

- Adverbs – Adds detail to verbs or other adverbs (quickly)
- Determiner – Placed in front of nouns to add detail or clarify – the, a, an
- Conjunction – Links words, phrases and clauses together
- Preposition – relation in terms of time/place – in, at, by, on

Sentence Types

- Simple – one clause
- Compound – Contains two or more clauses caused by coordinating conjunctions
- Complex – Two or more clauses, main clause and subordinate – main clause can stand alone
- Compound Complex – Contains both

Phrases and Clauses

- Phrase – part of a sentence, consists of one or more words that do not contain a verb
- Clause – a group of words clustered around a verb or verb phrase
