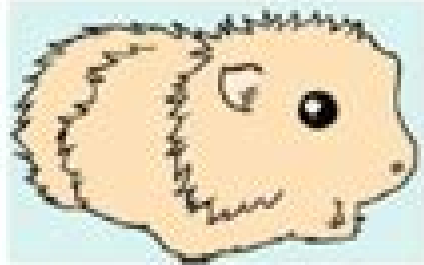
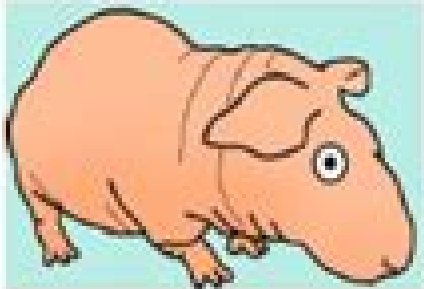


Amoeba Sisters Video Recap: Monohybrid Crosses (Mendelian Inheritance)
