Questions for Review and Discussion

1. The term *consent to financial presentation* — the primary government either appoints a ruling authority of the unit's governing body, or a majority of the unit's governing body is composed of primary government officials and
 - the primary government is able to prepare its own report on financial presentation and/or
 - there is the potential for the government to provide specific financial benefits to its citizens (either financial benefits or the primary government).
2. *Effective presentation* is when one or more component units are reported as separate entities other than pertaining to the primary government. *Blending* is when the component units' financials are included and reported as if they were part of the primary government — that is, the component units' funds are included the way as if they were funds of the primary government. *Blending* is required when the primary government and the component units are controlled by governing body. *Blending* also name themselves as the component and financials are reported as the primary government. If these conditions are not satisfied then effective presentation is required.
3. *Effective presentation* is a term that applies to government-wide statements, where the the aggregation of one number of different component units, irrespective of type and basis of accounting. Therefore, it is said, the government is really aggregated numbers is being asked. The problem is indicated by the requirement of the standard that all that the government provide financial information about each of its major component units.
4. The three main sections of the C.A.R.B. are:
 - mandatory section
 - financial section
 - statistical section

The main components of the financial section are:

 - auditor's report
 - management's discussion and analysis (MD&A)
