

2. For Turning Test:

This test is used to determine the speed in which a subject can pick up disks with one hand and turn them with the other hand before replacing the disks into holes of the testing board.

1. Pick up disk from upper right-hand corner with left hand
2. Turn disk over while passing it to the right hand and return it into the original hole with bottom side facing up. Continue in that row moving to the left
3. Repeat this action for the second row moving towards the right
4. Move right to left along board for third row (same as first row) and finally, left to right for fourth row (same as second row)
