Results show that integrated learning is no miracle cure but has positive and negative effects on specific student outcomes. Whereas integrated learning affects students' view of the relation between mathematics and science positively, it affects students' scientific self-concept negatively. Thus, integrated learning should not substitute but rather complement disciplinary learning.
