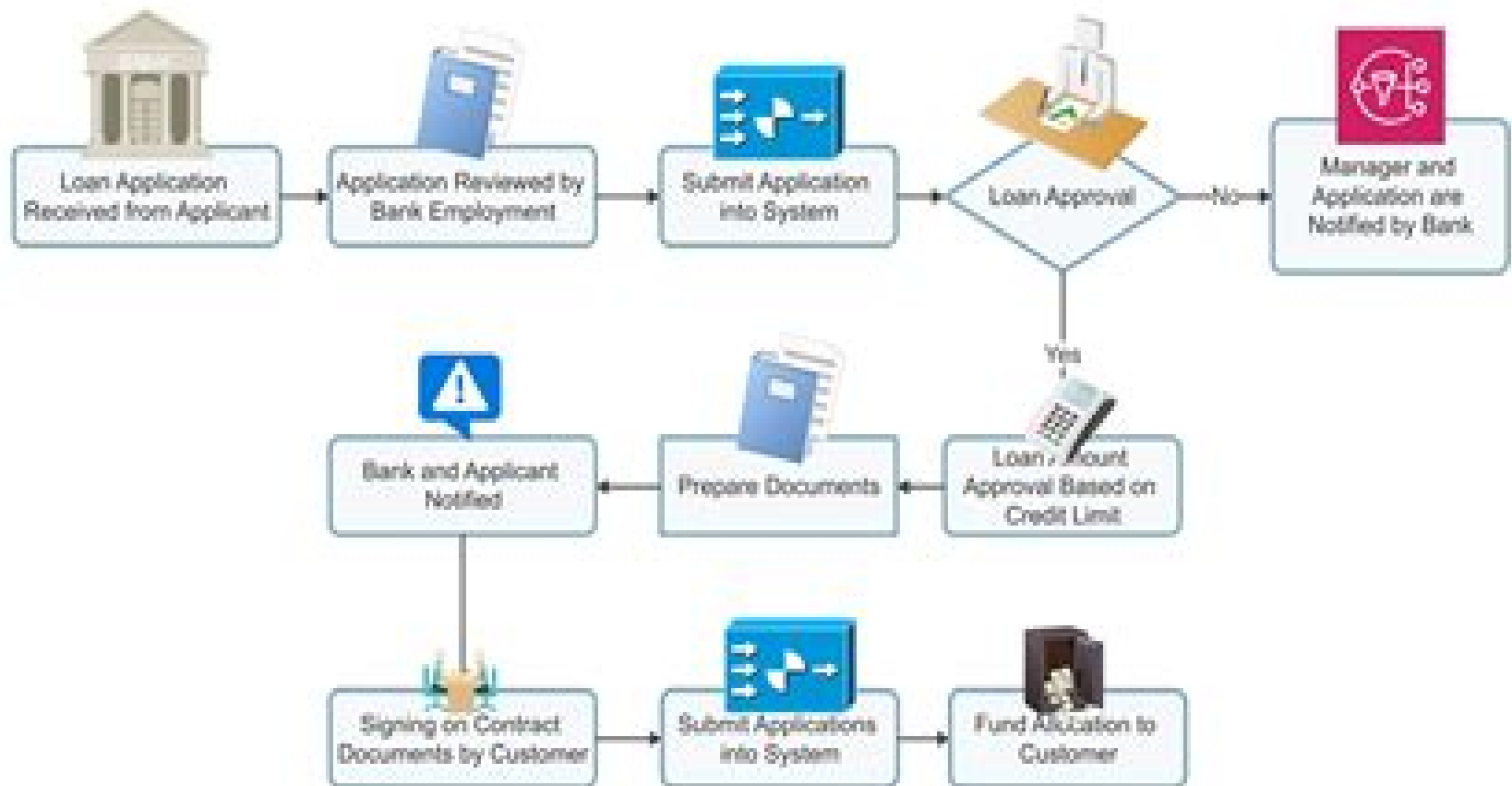


Bank Loan Process Flow Chart
