Pneumothorax is accumulation of air in pleural space of lung, pressure in pleural space causes lung to collapse. Can lead to tension pneumothorax, respiratory acidosis, infection at chest tube site, increased respiratory distress. Tx is needle aspiration, Heimlich valve, thoracotomy tube with underwater seal, oxygen and thoracentesis.

Brief review of topic:

Centrally administered into subclavian or internal jugular vein through catheter. Contains high concentrations of glucose and protein. Is a hypertonic solution and if given too rapidly client can have glucose overload and excessive diuresis with excretion of glucose. May develop dehydration, shock, HA, nausea, postural hypotension, motor seizures.

TOPIC OF QUESTION: Anticholinergic Medications

Brief review of topic:

Inhibit muscarinic actions of acetylcholine at autonomic nervous system receptor sites. Adverse effects are blurred vision, urinary retention, dry mouth, constipation, and HA. Avoid administration to clients with narrow-angle glaucoma, myasthenia gravis, GI obstruction.
