It is important to share God's love with those around us.



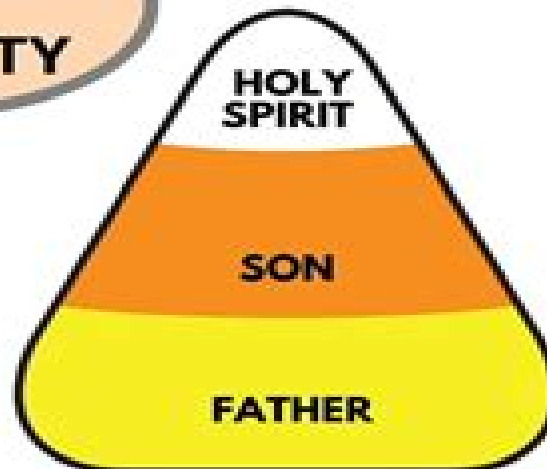
