Omnipotent – God is all powerful
Omniscient – God is all knowing / seeing
Omnibenevolent – God is all good
Omnipresent – God is everywhere and in everything
The Trinity – The idea that God is three things in one; Father, Son and Holy Spirit
Resurrection – The body stays in the grave until the end of the world when it will be raised by God and made everlasting
The Apostles' Creed – The statement of Christian beliefs
Catholic – A branch of Christianity, based in Rome and led by the Pope
Orthodox – A branch of Christianity mainly practised in Eastern Europe
Protestant – A branch of Christians who agree that the Bible is the only source of authority for Christians – originally called this as they protested against practices in the Catholic Church
Denomination – A distinct group within the Christian church, with its own organisation / traditions
Monotheistic – A religion that believes in only one God
Justice – bringing about what is right and fair according to the law
Holy Spirit – The third person of the Trinity whom Christians believe is the inspiring presence of God in the world
Creation – The act by which God brought the universe into being
The Word – Term used at the beginning of John's gospel to refer to God the Son
Incarnation – Becoming flesh, taking human form
Resurrection – Rising from the dead; a central Christian belief is that that Jesus did this
Blasphemy – A religious offence which includes claiming to be God
Crucifixion – Roman method of execution by which criminals were fixed to a cross
Ascension – The event when Jesus went up to heaven to rejoin the Father
Heaven – A state of eternal happiness in the presence of God
Purgatory – The intermediate state where souls are cleansed in order to enter heaven
Original sin – An Augustine doctrine that says everyone is born with a built in urge to disobey God
Salvation – Saving the soul, deliverance from sin and being allowed into heaven
Grace – A quality which God shows to humans by providing unconditional love and support
Atonement – Restoring the relationship between people and God through Jesus' death / resurrection
Satan – Name for the devil, the power and source of all evil
Day of Judgement – A time when the world will end and every soul will be rewarded / punished
Hell – The place of eternal suffering or the state of being without God
Sin – Any action or thought that separates humans from God; behaviour against God's laws
