

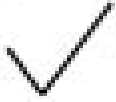
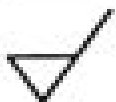



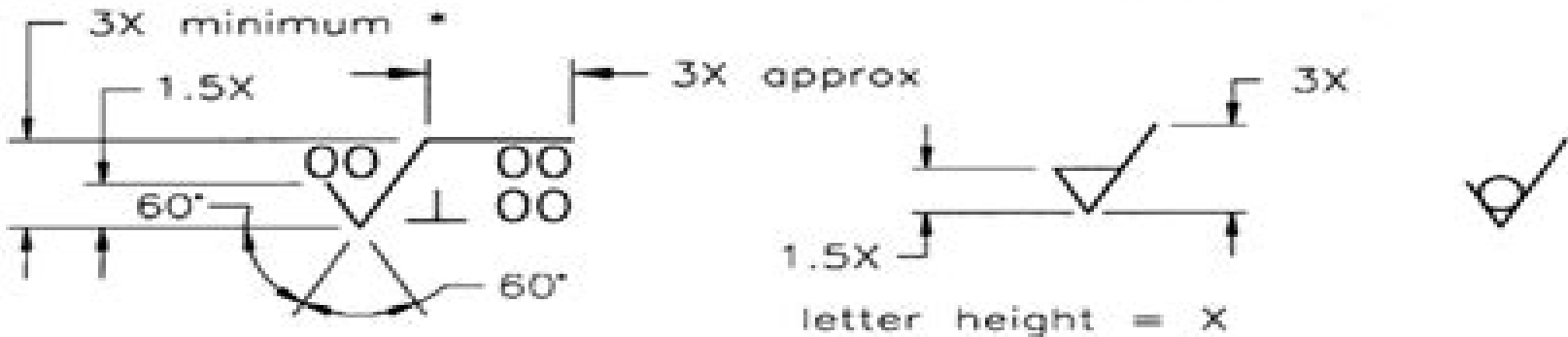
Symbol	Meaning
