- Physiological control system that maintains internal environment within narrow limits
- ENZYMES**
 - Enzymes, molecules
- CELLS**
 - If it malfunctioned in blood + tissue fluids

CONTROL MECHANISMS



Positive Feedback

- Deviation in the system
- Causes corrective response
- System continues to deviate
- eg. 1st stage - nerve potential

Negative Feedback

- Change the stimulus
- Corrective response
- Stabilise the system
- eg. 2nd stage - blood glucose

INFLUENCING FACTORS

- Diet - absorbing the nutrients
- Physiological - stress, illness, mood, etc.
- Genes/enzymes

DIABETES - A TYPE OF PANCREAS T1DC

- TYPE 1 Diabetes -
- When combining with physiological response
- Change in body structure of the pancreas (islets of Langerhans) - change shape + size -> decrease in glucose
- In the insulin case, part of the pancreas is destroyed
- In high insulin case, release cells with hormones, T1 is glucose insensitivity, control
- Insulin is not released
- Results in:
 - 1. increased glucose
 - 2. increased insulin
 - 3. increased glycogen
 - 4. increased glucose in the blood

DIABETES - A TYPE OF PANCREAS T2DC

- TYPE 2 Diabetes -
- Occurs during the blood plasma -
- Insulin is not released
- Insulin is released but the cells are not responding to it
- Insulin is released but the cells are not responding to it

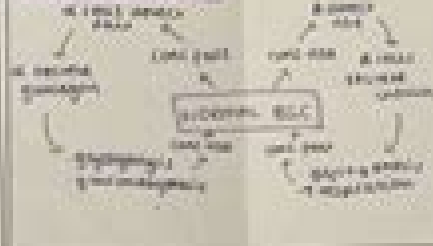
PROHORMONES

- Produced by endocrine glands + secreted during the blood plasma
- Carried to target cell
- Bind to receptor on target cell + complementary
- Produced in small quantities
- Wide spread and long-lasting effects

SECOND MESSENGER MODEL

- Used by 12 hormones: Adrenaline, Oestrogen
- 1. Binding of hormone to a transmembrane protein receptor causes signal to be sent inside
- 2. Activates the enzyme, which activates the second messenger, which activates the effector
- 3. Effector leads to protein kinase enzyme, changes the shape + activity
- 4. Activates conversion of glucose to glucose and the blood, T1DC

LIVER - REGULATING BLOOD SUGAR

Glycogenesis = Glucose -> Glycogen

- When BGC is higher than normal
- Insulin released into blood
- Causes glucose to be taken up by cells
- BGC decreases

Gluconeogenesis

- Production of glucose from glycogen + amino acids

Glycogenolysis = Glycogen -> Glucose

- When BGC is lower than normal
- Glucose released into blood
- Causes glucose to be taken up by cells
- BGC increases

CONTROL OF DIABETES

- Treatment for T1: Insulin therapy - high insulin (insulin not released)
- Insulin is injected - can remain high (hyperglycaemia)
- Insulin is injected - can remain low (hypoglycaemia)
- Treatment for T2: Insulin - not enough insulin
- Insulin is injected - can remain high (hyperglycaemia)
- Insulin is injected - can remain low (hypoglycaemia)
