Such comportment defines politickerization or negative competition. While attempting some possible responses to the numerous queries it raises, this book basically proffers the science of Four Eyesism as a discipline that all African schools need to institute and make a compulsory subject if the vandalized continent would have to be awakened to its realities. This book is rich in Fossungu's dazzling capacity to invent, define, and use a multitude of new terminological constructs informed by African experiences.
