discrimination paradigm to criminal law generates problems and anomalies For one thing members of minority groups are frequently hate crime perpetrators Moreover the underlying conduct prohibited by hate crime law is already subject to criminal punishment Jacobs and Potter question whether hate crimes are worse or more serious than similar crimes attributable to other anti social motivations. They also argue that the effort to single out hate crime for greater punishment is in effect an effort to punish some offenders more seriously simply because of their beliefs opinions or values thus implicating the First Amendment Advancing a provocative argument in clear and persuasive terms Jacobs and Potter show how the recriminalization of hate crime has little if any value with respect to law enforcement or criminal justice Indeed enforcement of such laws may exacerbate intergroup tensions rather than eradicate prejudice
