MR. LLOYD GEORGE, writing in the Daily Chronicle, on the General Election, says that "the only real advance was that made by the Liberals. In comparing the aggregate pell of 1923 with that of the election of 1922, the Tory pell has receded and the Labour vote does not represent any very substantial increase, but Liberalism made undoubted strides.

MR. NORMAN ANGELL ON NEED FOR SYSTEM OF BARGAINING

MR. NORMAN ANGELL has delivered an address on "Foreign Policy and the Business Man" at Stationers' Hall, before the Livery Committee of the Stationers' Company.

Mr. Angell said that two propositions were, to his mind, quite self-erident. First, that Great Britain's expecity to feed its population was not equal to more than half the present number. Therefore, we were largely dependent on foreign nations for our supplies, and if those nations had no more than enough for themselves. Great Britain could not maintain herself. If there were no world surpluses, our foreign trade would disappear, and our unemployed, instead of being, as now, a million and a half, would amount to even as many as five millions.

Secondly, if the international trade, by which we at present lived, was to be maintained, it must be embodied in an economic code, which would settle questions about

which the world had hitherto fought with bitterness.

His book, The Great Illusion, did not prophesy the impossibility of the unlikelihood of war; it actually screamed over the inevitability of war unless our foreign policy were changed, and we adopted a system of barguining instead of a policy of fighting. The point he made in his book was that, if we obtained a victory in any future war, we oughle not to use that victory for anything but obtaining trading rights.

The world had now experienced a great war, but what had happened? We had never been in a position of such political power, and we had never been in such an insecure position from the economic point of view. More than that, we had before us the prospect of a new war in the present condition of Europe, unless we set up the principle of bargaining. What was the good of pointing out these things to our statesmen? We had our opporbunity at Versailles, when we held the Central Powers at our mercy. If the Big Four had then announced a new economic code, it would have been accepted with both hands. that case, we should not have had the German mark at an astronomical figure; we should not have had a million and a half unemployed; and the income tax would not be what it was now.

S IR SIDNEY LOW, writing in the Weekly Dispatch on Profiteering and Prices," says:

"In England every producer is running under weights which make those of his competitors abroad seem light. To the State he pays in taxes, mostly direct taxes, between three and four times as much as the Frenchman, six times as much as the Frenchman, six times as much as the Italian, probably twenty times as much as the German, and a good deal more even than the American, whose obligations are to be substantially reduced next year.
