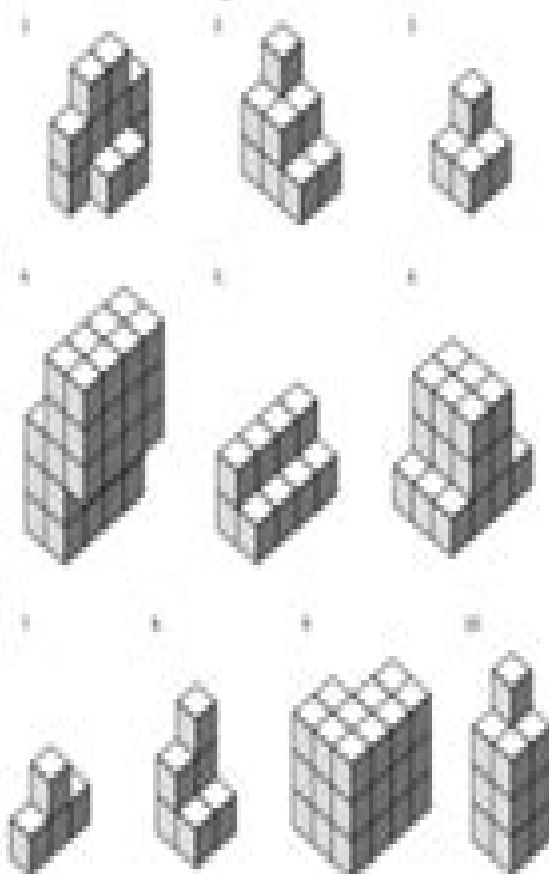

What is the volume of each shape below?

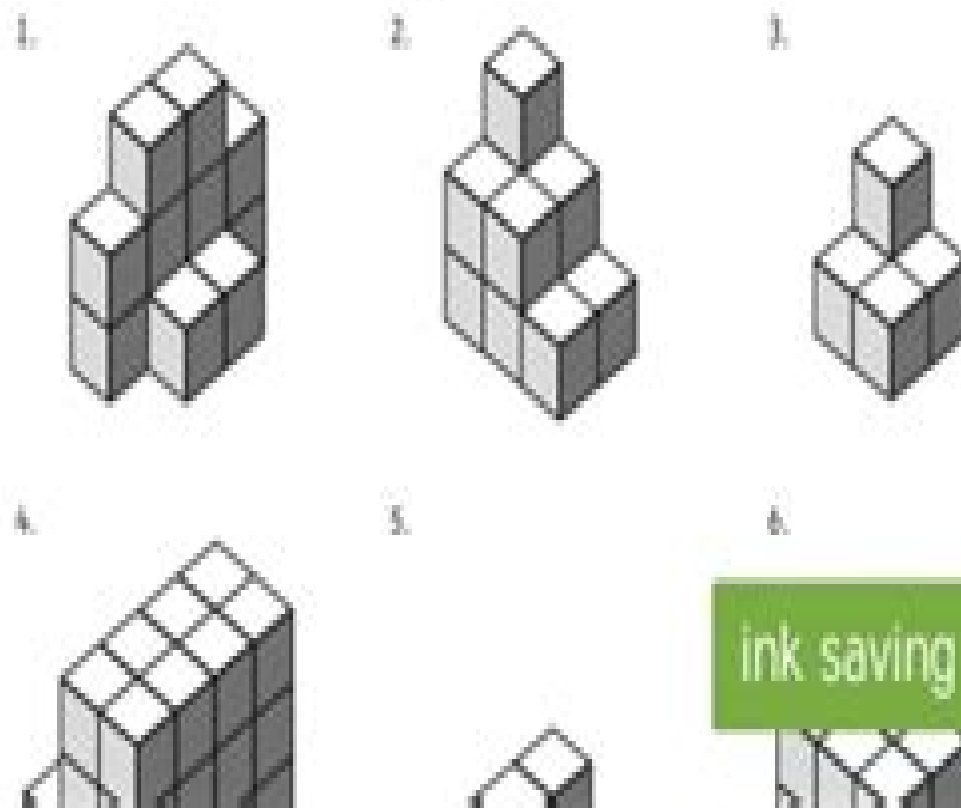
