Employment Equity in Canada Carol Agocs, 2014-07-31 In the mid 1980s the Abella Commission on Equality in Employment and the federal Employment Equity Act made Canada a policy leader in addressing systemic discrimination in the workplace More than twenty five years later Employment Equity in Canada assembles a distinguished group of experts to examine the state of employment equity in Canada today Examining the evidence of nearly thirty years the contributors both scholars and practitioners of employment policy evaluate the history and influence of the Abella Report the impact of Canada s employment equity legislation on equality in the workplace and the future of substantive equality in an environment where the Canadian government is increasingly hostile to intervention in the workplace They compare Canada s legal and policy choices to those of the United States and to the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities and examine ways in which the concept of employment equity might be expanded to embrace other vulnerable communities Their observations will be essential reading for those seeking to understand the past present and future of Canadian employment and equity policy Workplace Gazette ,2004

Changing Work Relationships in Industrialized Economies I?ik Urla Zeytino?lu, 1999-11-15 This book examines changing work relationships in industrialized economies within the context of economic restructuring and demographic variables The goal of this book is to examine experiences of industrialized economies in dealing with changing work relationships and discuss policy implications of creating such work relationships The thesis of the book is that non standard employment forms in restructuring economies affected all workers but particularly females and the youth Other demographic variables of education level race ethnicity immigrant status ability and economic class were also underlying forces in the construction and arrangements of non standard work Research shows both positive and negative effects of changing work relationships on workers though there is no conclusive result whether one or the other affect is stronger The discussion in this book pays attention to this debate and sheds light on it This book differs from others in its comprehensiveness of the coverage of work relationships referring to part time temporary casual telework and self employment without employees in its examination of a variety of variables including gender age race ethnicity immigrant status ability education level and economic class in the analysis of the topic in relation with the economic restructuring and in its initiative in collaboration of researchers from a variety of backgrounds and regions of the world that have expertise on changing work relationships

Good, Institute of Public Administration of Canada, 2003-01-01 David Good's *The Politics of Public Management* is a textbook case in public administration it deals with the events and circumstances surrounding the scandal of the grants and contributions audit at Human Resources Development Canada HRDC More specifically Good argues that the HRDC scandal or crisis was the result of a complex series of factors which transformed a fixable administrative matter into media headlines alleging that the government had lost one billion dollars The author further contextualizes this scandal by analyzing the dichotomies and contradictions inherent in public administration and supporting the larger premise that certain trade offs must be made in the administration of any public organization Good skillfully weaves together into a coherent and comprehensible whole both theoretical or conceptual and practical considerations He draws on current scholarship throughout his analysis and captures for the reader the nuances and complexities of public administration The first and only extensive critical examination to date of the events surrounding the scandal at HRDC this text offers an original and groundbreaking contribution to current scholarship on public administration and management in Canada

How Ottawa Spends, 2009-2010 Allan M. Maslove, 2009 This is the thirtieth volume in the series *How Ottawa Spends* It is arguable that never in these years have Canadians faced such serious economic upheaval and political dysfunction as the current climate The dramatic and seemingly sudden changes in the economy occurred simultaneously with a political drama one that was largely disassociated from the real and pressing economic challenge Early Harper budgets delivered lower taxes for all Canadians partly through highly targeted but politically noticeable small tax breaks on textbooks for students tools for apprentices in skilled trades and public transit costs The needs of the beleaguered average Canadian and the swing voter in the swing constituencies of an already strategized next election were a key part of Conservative agenda setting In the 2007 budget alone there were twenty nine separate tax reductions and federal spending was projected to increase by 10 billion including a 5.7 percent increase in program spending A small surplus of 3.3 billion was planned almost all of which would go to debt reduction As Harper savoured his 14 October 2008 re election with a strengthened minority government although without his desired majority he and his minister of Finance already knew that his surpluses were likely gone in the face of the crashing financial sector and a looming recession Future deficits were firmly back on the agenda Contributors include Malcolm G Bird Carleton University Chris Brown Carleton University G Bruce Doern Carleton University and University of Exeter Melissa Haussman Carleton University Robert Hilton Carleton University Ruth Hubbard University of Ottawa Edward T Jackson Carleton University Kirsten
