Non Visual Senses

- · People become more aggressive as temperatures go into uncomfortable ranges
 - Crime increases
- · Affinity increases with eye contact
- Physical warmth and social warmth stimulate the pleasure and reward center of the brain

Auditory pathways

- Outer Ear
 - External portion of the ear
 - Includes pinna, auditory canal, eardrum
- Pinna
 - Part of the outer ear that protrudes from the head
 - Funnels sound into the eardrum
- Auditory canal.
 - Tube in the outer ear that channels sound waves into the eardrum.
- Eardrum
 - Thin membrane that vibrates in response to incoming soundwaves
 - Separates the auditory canal from the middle ear
- Alternating bands or regions of high and low pressure in the sound wave cause the eardrum to vibrate at the same rate as the object that produced the sound wave
- Middle ear bones
 - Three small bones in the middle ear amplify the eardrum vibrations and pass them onto the cochlea
- Cochlea
 - Coiled, fluid-filled tube in the inner ear which sound vibrations trigger neural impulses
 - Shaped like a snail
 - When vibrations reach the cochlea, they jostle the fluid that fills the tube
- Movement in the cochlea bends tiny hair cells on the basilar membrane
 - Causes the hair cells to release neurotransmitters
 - The greater the vibrations, the more neurotransmitters are released
- Hair cells
 - Receptors for the auditory system
 - Located in the cochlea on the basilar membrane
- Basilar membrane
 - Thin membrane separates the cochlea into two main chambers
 - Contains the hair cells
- · Neural impulses pass through the auditory nerve to the thalamus
 - From there they are relayed to the auditory complex
