 - Purpose of accounting- To make sure that the portrait the company's accountants paint in the financial statements is as accurate as possible
 - I.E. True Disclosure
- Nature & Purpose of Accounting
 - Accounting is a technique and craft developed to help people monitor their economic transactions
 - Gives people a financial picture of their affairs
 - Fundamental purpose- to provide information about the economic dealings of a person or organization
 - Conceptual Framework (FASB)- a coherent system of interrelated objectives and fundamentals that is expected to lead to consistent standards and that prescribes the nature, function, and limits of financial accounting and reporting:
 - Expected to serve the public interest
 - Accounting Information
 - If the information is truthful, no ethical problems arise
 - If the information is not truthful, —
- Lying- a deceptive activity meant to evoke a certain response
 - Commission- untrue statements
 - Omission- withholding known pertinent information
- Proper Disclosure
 - The accountant must at least meet the disclosure requirements of all applicable governing authorities
- Obeying the law: brief history of accounting standards
 - Securities Act of 1933 and 1934
 - Congress' response to the Great Depression to promote ethical behavior through legislation and regulation
 - Established the SEC
 - Cohen Commission 1974
 - AICPA hired this commission to see if a gap may exist between what the public expects and needs and what auditors can and should reasonably expect to accomplish
 - Found that there wasn't enough focus on auditing- fault with the accounting profession for not keeping pace with the business environment
