5. What else do we find out about the narrator in this prologue and are there any similarities with Ethan?

The black wreath of a deciduous creeper flapped from the porch, and the thin wooden walls, under their worn coat of paint, seemed to shiver in the wind that had risen with the ceasing of the snow." What impression do we get of the house?
7. Why do you think Edith Wharton uses of three lines of dots (an ellipsis) at the end of the prologue?
