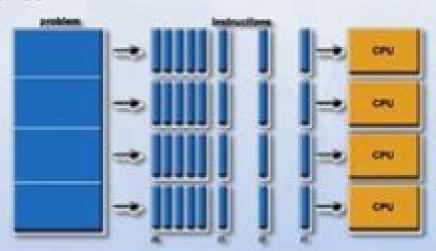
- In the simplest sense, parallel computing is the simultaneous use of multiple compute resources to solve a computational problem.
