Lesson Plan:

1. Have students brainstorm the meaning of 'equal', discussing equality, examples, when it might be used.
2. Read aloud the story.
3. Read to the children — discuss the main point — the fact = 1, total = 2 etc.
4. Demonstrate a balance of the animals, like a seesaw.
5. Have children explore the concept graphically with their own balances and numbers to work with, keep taking the animals to the story — challenging them to balance a bear and two rabbits for example with the other animals.
6. Demonstrate writing number sentences to match the balance, using the language: balance, equal, adding, more etc.
7. Use additional stories for further 'challenges' encourage that each situation needs words, pictures, math sentences and accuracy.
8. Return to the equal's brainstorming and ask the class if anything else can be added to the list.
