- Of those listed, Shem's longest living descendent was Eber his great-grandson. Eber lived until approximately 1817 B.C.
- Therefore, it seems safe to say most of the men mentioned in chapter 10 lived between 2350 B.C. and 1800 B.C. (a period of 750 years).

- Shem, Ham, and Japheth The three sons of Noah who accompanied him on the ark.
- Shem, Ham, and Japheth's Descendants They will be discussed in more detail in the outline.

#### Where:

- Shem, Ham, and Japheth disembarked from the ark in the mountains of Ararat.
- Over the next 750 years, their descendants spread across the face of the earth.
