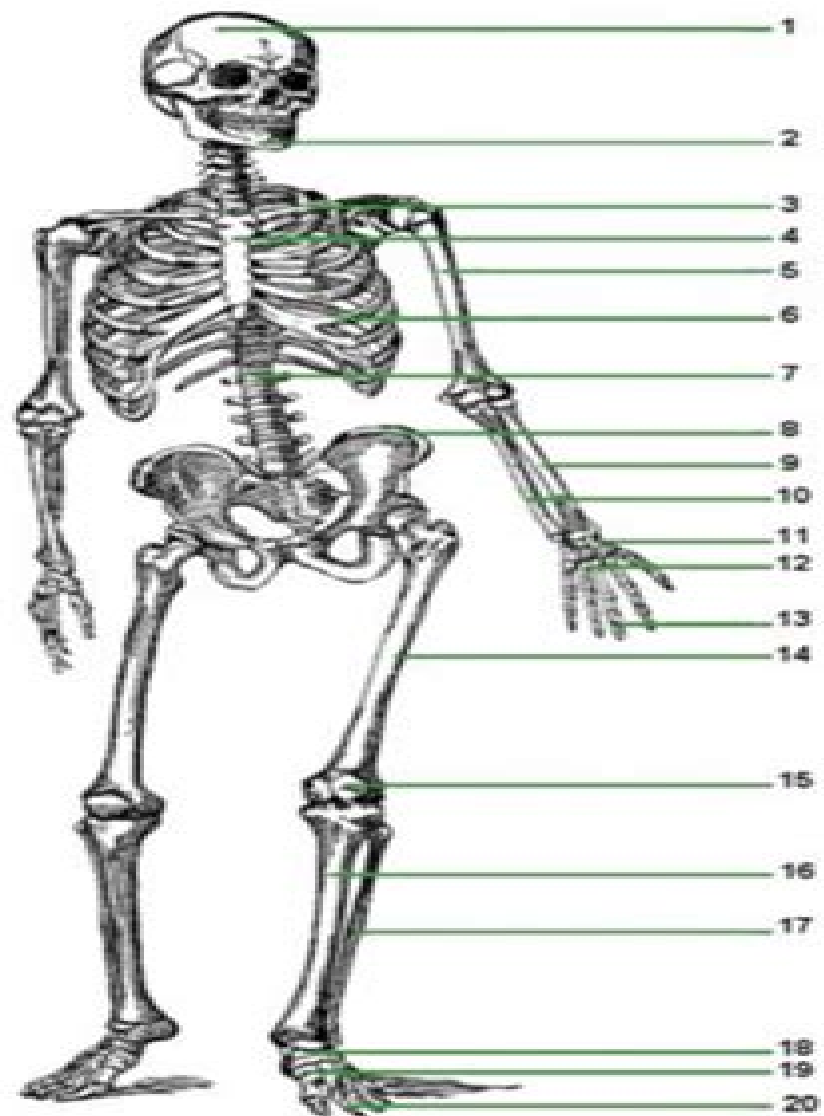


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HUMAN SKELETAL SYSTEM Color the diagram below using the table as a key.
