The first sensation seeking scale SSS had been developed in the early 1960 s based on these constructs At the time of his move to the University of Delaware in 1969 he turned his full

attention to the SSS as the operational measure of the optimal level constructs This was the time of the drug and sexual revolutions on and off campuses and research relating experience in these areas to the basic trait paid off and is continuing to this day in many laboratories Two books have been written on this topic Sensation Seeking Beyond the Optimal Level of Arousal 1979 Behavioral Expressions and Biosocial Bases of Sensation Seeking 1994 Research on sensation seeking in America and countries around the world continues at an unabated level of journal articles several hundred appearing since the 1994 book on the subject Integrative Complexity Within Antitheses ,
