- C. In France and in most other countries where the metric system of measurements is used, a comma is used to indicate a decimal while a period is used to indicate thousands, millions, etc. \$3,479.98 (read as \$3,479.98)

### PRONUNCIATION

- a. Unlike English, which stresses the pronunciation of a specific syllable within a word, French syllables are evenly stressed. The last syllable of a word, however, is slightly emphasized.
- b. Diacritical marks consist of three kinds of accent marks: *accent aigu*, *accent grave*, and *accent circumflex*; the *cedille* and the *tréma*.
1. The *accent aigu* is used to open up the sound of a vowel *e* when it is not followed by a final *a*, *i* or *u*: *cette*, *répète*, *celle*.
2. The *accent grave* is used:
  - a. on an open *e* at the end of a syllable or before a final *a*, *aire*, *tre*.
  - b. to differentiate two homographs (words spelled alike but which have a different meaning): *où* (where) and *ou* (or), *à* (in, up to and down), *à* (they and the other).
  - c. on the vowel *a* in words such as *ça*, *ça*, *ça*, *ça*, *ça*, *ça*, *ça*, *ça*, *ça*.
2. The *accent circumflex* is used on any of the five vowels:
  - a. to indicate that a formerly used vowel of *au* has been dropped: *littérature*, *littérature*, *littérature*, *littérature*.
  - b. to change the sound of certain vowels: *littérature*, *littérature*.
  - c. to differentiate two homographs: all great participles of such verbs and the construction of the *le*, *la*, *les* (past participles of verb endings) and *au* (past participles of verb endings, *au* (past) and *au* (past).
3. The *cedille* is used beneath the letter *c* when it precedes the vowels *a*, *e*, *i* to give it an *an* sound: *ça*, *ça*, *ça*, *ça*.
3. The *tréma* is placed above the vowels *a*, *i*, *u* to indicate that they are pronounced independently of any preceding or following vowel sound: *littérature*, *littérature*.

- C. Days of the week, months, numbers, and the letters of the alphabet are masculine.
- D. Names of most trees and bushes are masculine: un érable, un pommier.
- E. Soft drink trade names are masculine: un Coca, un Pepsi, un Orangina.
- F. Words borrowed from other languages are generally masculine: le tennis, le parking.
- G. The most common feminine noun endings are:

- A. When representing a date or the name of a month, only *ordinal* numerals are used. Otherwise, a *cardinal* numeral is used. In *premier* numbers two to nine mark François Premier (see Charles Chénier).

- A. An -n is added to most singular nouns to form their plural: *an flower/s flowers, an character/s characters.*
- B. If the noun already ends in -s, -x or -z, the plural form remains the same: *an children/children, in mother/s mothers, in crickets/crickets.*
- C. Most nouns ending in -al change to -en: *an cannibal/s cannibals, an character/s characters.*
- D. Exceptions to this rule are several words which only add an -s to form their plural: *bat, cat, curtain, channel, festival, vigil.*
- E. Most nouns ending in -us or -us form their plural by adding an -i: *an character/s characters, an barbarian/s barbarians.*
- F. Exceptions: *no geriatric geriatrics.*
- G. Most nouns ending in -ell normally add an -s to form their plural: *an strudel/s strudels.*
- H. Exceptions to this rule are nine nouns which change -ell to -en to form their plural: *hall/hallen, carnival/carnivals, cannibal/cannibals, conspirator/conspirators, travel/travels, wastrel/wastrels, and vitell/vitells.*
- I. Most nouns ending in -us add an -s to form their plural: *an brother/s brothers.*
- J. Exceptions are the following seven words which add an -i: *hippo/hippos, calico/calicos, cheetah/cheetahs, gnu/gnus, llama/llamas, joujou/joujous, and poujou/poujous.*
- K. Some nouns have two forms for their plural forms, each form having a different meaning or source: *straw/straws/straws.*
